### Copyright Concerns

Copyright permission is not required for photographic duplication for personal or research use in cases where the Briscoe Center controls copyright. *Where the Briscoe Center is not the copyright holder, proof in writing of permission from the copyright holder must be presented for photographic reproductions, regardless of use.*

Clearance of copyright is always the responsibility of the person wishing to publish or display material. Patrons are responsible for securing permission to reproduce materials either from the Briscoe Center or from other copyright holders and for complying with copyright laws.

In all cases, written permission to publish or display reproductions of the Briscoe Center materials must be secured from the Briscoe Center as owner of the physical property prior to the use of the materials. Patrons must fill out a Request for Permission to Publish or Use Reproduction of Materials form. All images that are published or displayed must include the Briscoe Center's credit line alongside the image. *A complimentary copy of the final publication in any medium using reproductions of Dolph Briscoe Center for American History materials must be donated to the Briscoe Center.*
