The enclosed copy will instruct Your Lordship of the opinion given by the assessor general and of my subsequent concurring decree. This concerns the settling and establishment of the pueblo of Bucarely.

I ask you as much in virtue of the complete satisfaction I have of Your Lordship's proven zeal and ability, as in virtue of this being a matter of the greatest importance--concerning which I must report to His Majesty for his sovereign ^{lv} // approval.

In spite of these considerations, if by chance your health should not permit Your Lordship to personally execute this commission, you may entrust it immediately to the subject whom you deem most appropriate and in whom are found the qualifications required for the discharge of such a delicate mission.
